Illinois Secretary of State Launches New Route 66 Motorcycle Plate Program

Springfield, IL – 6/4/18 - Illinois motorcycle owners now have an opportunity to join car owners from across the state to support perhaps the most famous road in the world, Route 66, by registering for the newly released Illinois Route 66 Motorcycle Plate. State Representative Tim Butler of the 87th District who sponsored the legislation that brought the plate to reality noted, "Route 66 is a historic part of our American culture. The Mother Road starts in downtown Chicago and stretches across more than 300 miles of Illinois."
