Litchfield Museum & Route 66 Welcome Center

This new museum is located where the Vic Suhling gas station once stood. The retro design of the building, with exterior neon trim and restored neon Suhling sign welcomes visitors. Ariston Café

Pete Adam started the Ariston Café in nearby Carlinville in 1924. When the Mother Road was rerouted in 1929, Pete leased a new building in Litchfield. The Ariston's great reputation for service, excellent food and unbelievable desserts led Pete to relocate across the street in 1935 to his own building that still stands today. The family still offers the same wonderful food and great service that it has for over 90 years. It is said to be the oldest café on Route 66. The Ariston was named to the National Register of Historic Places and is in the Route 66 Hall of Fame

Jubelt's Bakery

Jubelt's is a third generation family business that began as a bakery in Mt. Olive, IL in 1922. Jubelt's has been in Litchfield since 1952 and on Route 66 since 1982. In the last 90 years, the bakery has adapted to meet the changing lifestyles and the demands of customers, much like The Mother Road. A full service bakery, Jubelt's features homemade soups, salads, handformed burgers, specialty sandwiches, dinners, and fresh bakery items such as donuts, Danish, cinnamon rolls, pies, pastries, cookies, cakes, bread, and much more. Stop by and bring a healthy appetite. Jubelt's was inducted in 2017 into the Route 66 Association of Illinois Hall of Fame.

Lake Lou Yaeger Recreation Area

Lake Lou Yaeger is a 1,400 acre lake popular with boaters and fishers. A 300-acre park along its shores includes picnic areas, playgrounds, campgrounds, beach, Route 66 hike/bike trail and horse trails with full-service campground. Located on the South-East side of Lake Lou Yaeger, the 266 acre Shoal Creek Conservation Area has two easy hiking trails. This beautiful area is home to well over 700 species of plants, 70 species of butterflies, and 70 species of breeding birds. Enjoy a self-guided tour through native prairie lands, shoreline woods, and take in the magnificent views of the lake and surrounding areas. To get the most out of your visit to Lake Lou Yaeger, bring a pair of binoculars and try to spot the area's Bald Eagles.

Sky View Drive in Theatre

The Sky View opened in the spring of 1951 and has been in seasonal operation since. It is the last remaining original operating drive-in theatre on Route 66 in Illinois. Inducted in 1998 into the Route 66 Association of Illinois Hall of Fame.

Niehaus Cycle Sales

Niehaus Cycle Sales, Inc. is a family owned business that started in 1970 by the late William Niehaus, and now is operated by all three of his sons. In 1971, the business was incorporated and acquired a Yamaha franchise. In 1976 a Honda franchise was added. The current location, which was renovated in 1999, is housed in a retro building with exterior neon trim themed to Route 66. The 12,000+ square ft. main showroom offers, in addition to the latest Yamaha and Honda motorcycles, more than 10,000 parts and accessories that are on display. Niehaus hosts an annual gathering in May that attracts over 5000 people.

"Drive In" and Enjoy

Glowing neon signs lined Route 66 through Litchfield, beckoning travelers to stop at service stations, hotels, and restaurants. Local farmers woke at dawn to drive their trucks loaded with cattle to the East St. Louis Stockyards. Litchfield residents gathered in cafes to share news and socialize. These places nurtured a sense of community, which continues today.

The Ariston Cafe

Eat a delicious meal across the street at the Ariston, one of the oldest operating restaurants on Route 66. The neon signs still beckon travelers, as they did when it moved to its current location in 1935.

Sky View Drive In

Enjoy an outdoor movie at the Sky View Drive In, located just north of here along the 1940-1977 Route 66 alignment. Opened in 1950, it is the last original Route 66 drive-in theater in Illinois.
