

# Willowbrook, Illinois Community Profile Overnight Itinerary



Willowbrook became one of the State's smallest villages on January 18, 1960 when it was incorporated with 167 residents. After that time, State law required at least 400 residents before an area could be incorporated. Today there are over 8500 residents in this Chicago suburb known for its community parks and excellent public school system.

If you're looking for famous fried chicken during your Illinois Route 66 travels, definitely consider Dell Rhea's Chicken Basket as your stop outside of Chicago. They've been famous for their fried chicken since 1939.

#### The Chicken Basket

Most businesses on Route 66 began as combinations of gas stations, garages, and lunch counters. At the Chicken Basket, tasty food won out over gasoline sales. Throughout the 1940s and 50s, hungry travelers flocked to the popular restaurant. But in 1962, the new Interstate Highway cut off flourishing businesses from the lifeblood of traffic. Some like the Chicken Basket, survived.

#### An Idea is Hatched

In 1939, two local farm women approached gas station and diner owner, Irv Kolarik. They proposed to share their secret fried chicken recipe if he promised to buy all his chickens from them. Irv agreed, sales soared, and the gas station became history. Having outgrown his lunch counter, Irv Kolarik built a new Chicken Basket restaurant next door to his original gas station and diner in 1946.

#### Dell Rhea's

With the opening of I-55, the chicken Basket fell on hard times. A Chicago businessman, Delbert (Dell) Rhea, bought the Chicken Basket in 1963. He reinvigorated business with an advertising campaign aimed at suburbanites and travelers searching for old Route 66.
